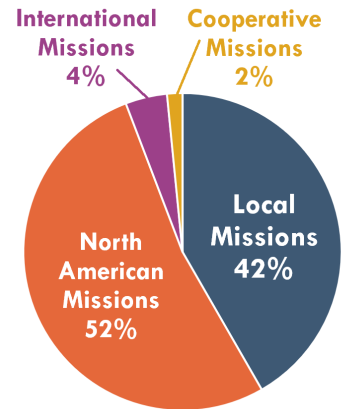

Filled with toys and practical gifts donated to impoverished children through **OLIVE BRANCH MINISTRIES** in southern KY.



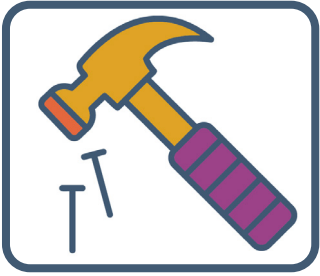
